

Dear Colleague,

Once again, thank you for applying to be part of the CUR Transformations project, (funded by NSF-EHR DUE grant 16-25354). As we noted in our earlier communications to you, we received an overwhelming response to our call for institutions to participate in the project. As we only have funding to support twelve (12) institutions, it is clear that a number of well-qualified institutions will not be able to participate directly in all of the aspects of the project.

We are currently exploring some alternate ways for institutions to participate in the CUR Transformations project, and also plan to seek supplemental funding to include more institutions in different aspects of the project. We anticipate having more information about these alternate pathways in the summer or fall of 2017. In the meantime, one immediate strategy we recommend is for applicants to thoroughly connect with the CUR membership community, and take advantage of CUR's varied activities and programs. Judging from some of the questions we've received from applicants, it seems likely that some of you would enjoy being more fully engaged with the information resources available through CUR.
